



S. Casey Tate

Capital Improvement Program Director

Casey Tate, a Texas A&M University graduate, came to the City of Irving in 1985 to fill the position of Superintendent of Park Planning and Construction. As Superintendent, Casey managed the professional design team in the design and development of new and renovated park facilities and City-wide corridor enhancements. He developed grant applications to secure \$9.6 million funding for development projects.

Through the years responsibilities grew and he was promoted to Construction and Building Services Director. In this role Casey managed the department responsible for the design, development of City-wide buildings, park facilities, trails and corridor improvements. Responsible for the daily maintenance and custodial services for 78 City Buildings, he managed 54 employees including Building Maintenance, HVAC Services, Custodial and Planning & Development.

In his current position, Capital Improvement Program Director, Casey now Manages the Department responsible for the design, development of all City-wide capital improvement projects; including road and street projects, water and sewer projects, municipal buildings, park facilities, trails and corridor improvements.

Some of Casey's past significant projects include Irving Convention Center; Cimarron Park & West Irving Aquatic Centers; 11+ miles of Campi3n Trails; Irving Animal Care Campus; Valley Ranch, West Irving and South Irving Libraries; and MacArthur Corridor Improvements. The 81 person CIP Team currently has 84 active projects worth over \$230 million in various stages of design and construction.

In addition Casey is the recipient of numerous Park Development and Design Awards dating back to 1992. He is a licensed Landscape Irrigator and licensed Landscape Architect in the State of Texas with too many professional affiliations to list.
